

BAILY, Mary died June 13, 1856; Ae 57 yrs Wife of Moses Baily (Stone broken)

BICKFORD, E.W. died Feb 5, 1890; Ae 72 yrs, 4 ms, 15 ds

DAY, Sylvanus died June 14, 1864; Ae 45 yrs, 2 ms  
 "Father I give my spirit up. I trust it in thy hand.  
 My dying flesh shall rest in hope and rise at thy command."

DAY, Wilbur S. died Dec 1, 1863; Ae 1 yr, 11 ms, 13 ds Son of Sylvanus & Mary J. Day  
 "Alas thou changed that lovely flower which bloomed and changed my heart  
 Fair fleeting comfort of an hour how soon we're called to part"

FRENCH, Mary Jane 1865 - 1949 (No marker found in 1999)

HALEY, John J. died May 4, 1869; Ae 53 yrs, 8 ms, 27 ds  
 "Brother, thou art gone to rest. Thy toils and cares are o'er.  
 And sorrow, pain and suffering now, shall ne'er distress thee more."

HALEY, Thankful died Aug 4, 1857; Ae 37 yrs Wife of J.J. Haley  
 "The grave is now a favored spot to saints who sleep in Jesus blest.  
 For there the wicked trouble not, and there the weary are at rest"

JEWELL, Thomas died Mar 7, 1881; Ae 79 yrs, 2 ms, 15 ds Father

JEWELL, Nancy J. died Sept 17, 1881; Ae 70 yrs, 8 ms, 28 ds Mother

JEWELL, George W. died Sept 20, 1834; Ae 3 ms Son of Thomas & Nancy Jewell

JEWELL, Nancy J. died Aug 26, 1840; Ae 5 ms Dau of Thos & Nancy Jewell

JEWELL, Lucinda died Dec 13, 1855; Ae 17 yrs, 5 mos, 13 ds Dau of Thos & Nancy Jewell

LIBBY, Susan died Aug 14, 1879; Ae 75 yrs, 2 ms, 14 ds Wife of Phineas Libby  
 "Sleep on dear Mother and take thy rest. God called on thee as he thought best."

LIBBY, Lucy died Mar 16, 1852; Ae 19 yrs Dau of Phineas & Susan Libby

MARTIN, John D. died Mar 21, 1887; Ae 64 yrs, 20 ds

MARTIN, Caroline Jewell died Nov 14, 1912; Ae 82 yrs, 10 ms, 13 ds Wife of John D. Martin

MARTIN, Walter S. died Jan 3, 1897; Ae 35 yrs, 4 mos, 25 ds

MARTIN, Lucinda J. died Sept 17, 1852; Ae 11 mo, 3 ds Dau of J. D. & Caroline Martin

PIERCE, John died Dec 10, 1889; Ae 80 yrs

PIERCE, Ruth died Feb 2, 1897; Ae 89 yrs His wife

TINSMAN, Dennis died Sept 11, 1904; Ae 55 yrs, 2 ms

WEED, John died Sept 25, 1883; Ae 75 yrs, 3 ms  
 No chilling winds, nor poisonous breath can reach that healthful shore  
 Sickness and sorrow, pain and death are felt and feared no more

WEED, Mary died Feb 20, 1898; Ae 92 yrs, 8 mos, 24 ds Wife of John Weed  
 Mother, though from yonder sky cometh neither voice nor cry  
 Yet we know for the day every pain hath passed away

WEED, Henry \* died Nov 26, 1866; Ae 34 yrs, 8 mo Son of John & Mary Weed Civil War  
 "Dread omnipalance alone can heal the wound he gave  
 Can paint the brimful grief worn eyes to scenes beyond the grave"

WEED, Charles died Dec 11, 1842; Ae 4 yrs, 2 ms Son of John & Mary Weed

WHITNEY, William died May 4, 1859; Ae 64 yrs, 4 mos

WHITNEY, Mrs. Anna died Sept 28, 1849; Ae 52 yrs Wife of William Whitney

WHITNEY, Jane S. died Mar 28, 1846; Ae 6 yrs, 1 m Dau of Wm & Anna Whitney

Note: There are four definite field stones used as markers with three footstones – all with no engravings. They are between the Libby and John and Thankful Haley stones. To the left of Susan Libby's stone, there is one definite fieldstone marker with no engraving.
