 "Bear her gently Holy Angels Through the ranks of God's evangel

- BUTLER, Willie T. died Nov 30, 1862; Ae 6 yrs, 8 ms Son of D. & E.A. Butler
 "From your parents little Willie Early was thou called away

- POOR, Almira Barker died July 15, 1881; Ae 74 yrs, 2 ms, 8 ds Wife of Tyler P. Poor

- POOR, Susan F. died May 9, 1852; Ae 23 yrs, 11 ms, 16 ds Dau of Tyler & Almira Poor
 "She is gone, she is gone that chosen one Her joys are earth's victories won
 Just in the morning of her day When hope was bright, she passed away"
- POOR, Charles O. died Apr 7, 1845; Ae 13 yrs, 14 ds Son of T.P. & Almira Poor
